

The most important problem:

According to the common, usually testing results, during the so called "sero negative period" all the infected persons, which could be considered even "carriers", are considered as non infected, as long as there are not enough specifically detectable antibodies in their body.

The simple solution:

- 1 A small blood sample will be transferred in HIV/HCV detectable SMARTube™.



- 2 It will be incubated at 37°C for a period of time of three to five days.
- 3 After incubation, a sample of the supernatant, separated from the rest of the blood, is removed for further testing process, using just any available ELIZA test.
